Request for Proposal (RfP) for Appointment of Charge Point Operators (CPOs) for Supply, Erection, Testing, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance (O&M) of Electric Vehicle Public Charging Stations at identified locations in Andhra Pradesh.

1.	Clause 1.5 – Bid Parameter - Page No. 17 of the RfP	i) Each Cluster shall be evaluated and awarded separately under the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) methodology specified in Clause 5.5. For each Cluster, the Bidder obtaining the highest QCBS Score for that Cluster shall be declared as the Preferred Bidder for that Cluster and, subject to the provisions of this RfP, shall be the Selected Bidder for that Cluster. A single Bidder shall be awarded only one (1) Cluster. ii) In the event that a Bidder secures the highest QCBS score for more than one Cluster, NREDCAP may require such Bidder to indicate its Cluster preference. NREDCAP shall, however, retain the right to make final allocation in a manner that is in the overall interest of the Project, subject to the general principle that no Bidder shall ordinarily be awarded more than one (1) Cluster. iii) Provided, however, that in exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to situations where no other Qualified Bidder is available or eligible for award of a particular Cluster, NREDCAP may, at its sole discretion and for reasons to be recorded, award more than one (1) Cluster to the same Bidder.	i) Each Cluster shall be evaluated and awarded separately under the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) methodology specified in Clause 5.5. For each Cluster, the Bidder obtaining the highest QCBS Score for that Cluster shall be declared as the Preferred Bidder for that Cluster and, subject to the provisions of this RfP, shall be the Selected Bidder for that Cluster. Ordinarily, a single Bidder shall be awarded only one (1) Cluster, subject to the exceptional circumstances specified herein. ii) In the event that a Bidder secures the highest QCBS score for more than one Cluster, NREDCAP may require such Bidder to indicate its Cluster preference. NREDCAP shall, however, retain the right to make final allocation in a manner that is in the overall interest of the Project, subject to the general principle that no Bidder shall ordinarily be awarded more than one (1) Cluster. iii) Provided, however, that in exceptional circumstances, NREDCAP may, at its sole discretion and for reasons to be recorded, award more than one (1) Cluster to the same Bidder. Such exceptional circumstances may include:

		iv) If the Preferred Bidder for any Cluster withdraws its Bid or is not selected for any reason, the Authorized Representative may, at its discretion, invite the Qualified Bidder with the next best QCBS Score for that Cluster to match the Quoted Price of the Preferred Bidder for that Cluster, if the price quoted by such Qualified Bidder is higher than that of the Preferred Bidder. If the Qualified Bidder agrees to match the Quoted Price of the Preferred Bidder, it shall be declared the Preferred Bidder. If the Qualified Bidder fails to match the Quoted Price of the Preferred Bidder, the Authorized Representative may take any measures it deems fit, at its sole discretion, including: (i) inviting the Qualified Bidder with the next best QCBS Score to match the Quoted Price of the Preferred Bidder; or (ii) annulling the entire Bid Process.	a. where no other Qualified Bidder is available or eligible for award of a particular Cluster. b. where the same Bidder emerges as the Preferred Bidder / highest ranked Bidder based on QCBS Score for more than one Cluster and NREDCAP is satisfied that such Bidder has demonstrated superior technical, operational, financial and execution capabilities, and possesses the overall capacity and preparedness required to ensure timely and successful implementation, operation and maintenance of the Project across more than one Cluster. For the purpose of considering exceptional allocation under this sub-clause (b), NREDCAP may evaluate factors including, but not limited to, ownership of an in-house developed CMS and mobile application, quality and market standing of the mobile application, demonstrated execution capability, availability of a service centre in Andhra Pradesh or commitment to establish the same prior to commencement of operations and willingness to match the quoted rates of the H2 bidder wherever the H1 bidder's rates are higher. The final decision on award of multiple clusters shall rest solely with NREDCAP, keeping in view the

			objective of ensuring the highest standards of service quality, operational reliability, and successful implementation of the project. iv) If the Preferred Bidder for any Cluster withdraws its Bid or is not selected for any reason, the Authorized Representative may, at its discretion, invite the Qualified Bidder with the next best QCBS Score for that Cluster to match the Quoted Price of the Preferred Bidder for that Cluster, if the price quoted by such Qualified Bidder is higher than that of the Preferred Bidder.
